Some changes made in response. • Tried to keep the tone level, not boastful, evidence based. • Sent to faculty for final (final) review. • Now readying to answer core questions at the site visit... PFC committees should be ready for them (not just a single person) • Site visit will end with debrief with the Dean to give positive and any negative feedback • [Q: Standard 25 – correct evaluations omitted for “2021” to “2020”. A: No, 2020 activity was not reviewed in 2021, delayed and then both 2020 and 2021 done in 2022.] • [Q: After site visit? A: ACPE will review, provide us with draft report – can dispute factual inaccuracies, then in June learn ACPE Board vote on full/other reaccreditation. • Final Self Study Report - Moved for approval <i>K Franson</i>, seconded <i>W Gong</i>, 50 Ayes, 1 Abstention, 0 Nays 	Approved
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Faculty Spotlight <i>S Bain</i> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • TRAQS – Team-based Regulatory and Quality Solutions • Allows interdisciplinary team of students to work on an industry Sponsor proposed project • Gives students real world experience in team projects • Examples: Regulatory Strategy, Clinical Trial Strategies, Market Launch Strategies, Competitive Intelligence • Iterative 15 week (semester) process, 4-6 students, often >1000 person hours (15/wk/std), deliverables include both written report and corp. presentation. • Obviously, also great value proposition for companies; bandwidth extension, opportunity to liase, potential hiring of students. • Companies must contract (\$30K), students get 3 semester credits • [Q: Conflict of interest for currently employed students? A: Rare. One case so far. Was no actual conflict.] • [Q: If student already has expertise, how to balance the experience? A: Need to be careful. Used experienced student to train another.] • [Q: Average number of students per year? Open to alumni? A: Need to avoid Cofl and offer option to students. May offer the service (not the experience) to alumni.
